MOVING TIPS

- ✓ Contact your insurance agent and ask about renter's insurance!
- ✓ Start collecting boxes (small & large). Set aside extras for last minute items on moving day.
- Create a box for your moving day supplies (tape, colored markers, bags, labels, plastic wrap, tools, etc.).
- ✓ Pack rarely used items ahead of time
- ✓ Start a list of which items are in which boxes for easier tracking.
- ✓ Pack things in order of how you want them to come out. It takes a little extra time, but will make unpacking much easier.
- ✓ Avoid mixing items from different rooms in the same box.
- ✓ Always pack your boxes solid, even if the majority of it is newspaper. This will prevent items from sliding around without adding much weight.
- ✓ Pack each room individually. It is better to pack room by room so you avoid mixing items.
- ✓ Use sheets, extra blankets, towels, throw pillows, stuffed animals and oven mitts for packing delicate items. (protect with garbage bags)

- ✓ Take pictures of electronic wiring –
 cable, stereos, computers, video game
 systems
- ✓ Make a Priority Box that has everything that you'll need when you get to your new home.
- ✓ Use suitcases for heavier items.
- ✓ Use plastic wrap around drawers & containers to seal things in place.
- ✓ Use paper bags instead of newspaper. They're thicker, they won't bleed, and you can start collecting them at the grocery store.
- ✓ Place a fitted sheet on both sides of your mattress to help keep it clean.
- ✓ Keep parts, screws, and hardware together using baggies and labels.
- ✓ Have cash on hand for unexpected expenses during the move.
- ✓ Do not attach tape directly to polished or painted wood finishes.
